TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND POLICY COMMITTEE Monday, May 20, 2024, Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order and Roll Call

Policy Committee Chair, Dick Stauffer, called the meeting to order at 9:30 am and Kim Gallagher conducted roll call.

2. Changes to the Agenda

None.

3. Public Comment

None.

4. Approval of The May 20, 2024, Meeting Minutes

Motion to approve the minutes from the April 15th, 2024, TwinCATS combined Policy and Technical Advisory Committee meeting as included in the meeting packet. Made by Jim Sturdevant and seconded by Roger Seeley. **Motion approved.**

5. SWMPC Staff Report

Gallagher gave an update on the 2026-2029 TIP development process. The Call for projects was emailed to all TwinCATS members the last week of June. Applications are due on Friday September 27th. The CMAQ and Carbon Reduction call for projects will be sent out at the end of July or early August. MDOT should have funding estimates for all programs by the end of august, but they expect the finding to be similar to previous years.

6. Local Road Agency Updates

All 2023 proejctsh ave been constructed. The Berrien County Road Department is scheduling constution dates for their 2024 proejcts.

Drews gave an update on the City of BentonHarbor's proejects:

Colfax Avenue Reconstruction: The preocjt is being held up by the MDOT archeologist who has classified the area as a arcehologicaly and tribally sensitive. They require a fulltime archeoloist present during construction which will cost the city approximately \$80,000, which the city does not have.

Empire and Colfax Signal: Construction will start in the fall. Delivery times for mast arms is 6 months, so construction should be completed next spring.

Jefferson Sreet Rehabilitaiton: OCnstruction will begin shortly

7. Transit Updates

Gallgher gave an update for TCATA. Rufus Adams, the director of TCATA, has resigned. Todd Schurn, a Howard University professor who had worked on the University of Michigan plan for TCATA, will serve as interim director for 6 weeks. Leadership after this is uncertain. The FTA tirennal audit will occur in September, and the state has offered to assist TCATA with this.

Gallagher presented ridership and financial trends for TCATA's Dial A Ride service from 2019-2023, highlighting the impacts of COVID-19 and subsequent recovery efforts. She emphasized that the system has not yet regained its prepandemic ridership levels. Service hours have fallen by 25% while total ridership dropped by 52%, leading to a 124% increase in the cost per passenger.

Gillespie commented again that this further supports the need for a single countywide transit system. he highlighted that there is now 22% of the county which is in an urban area without transit service.

8. TCATA Amendment Request

Gallagher briefly explained the amendment, explaining that by switching a proejct from 2023 to 2024, it increases the cost in 2024 by over 25%.

9. MDOT Project Updates

See meeting packet page 7 and 8 for MDOPTproejct updates.

M-139 Project Update: Jon Smith reported that the base plans for the M-139 project were completed and sent to stakeholders. MDOT is seeking a grant for this project. If the grant is awarded, the entire project from I-94 to I-94BL/Main Street will be constructed in 2026. If the grant is not received, only the section from Napier to I-94BL/Main Street will be constructed in 2026, with the southern portion planned for 2030 or 2031.

Main Street/M-63 proejct in St. Joseph: Smith reported that the EPE phase for the is wrapping up and the plans were sent to the city fo approval.

10. MDOT Project Amendments

Gallagher noted that the hydraulics for the Bicentennial Bridge, which carries I-94BL/Main Street over the St. Joseph River, require urgent repairs. This is why approving the proejct now is critical. Smith added that plans would be turned in in about 2 weeks, with letting occurring in October.

11. Non-morotized Project Amendments

See meeting packet page 9and 10 for amendment details

Roosevelt Path: Disck Stauffer explained that the proejct began in 2017, with designes completed and bids in 2019. But costs came in too high and the proejct didn't move forward. Congressman Tim Walberg was looking for shovel ready proejcts to award earmark funds, and Stauffer presented this proejct. The high cost is due to the deigns standards required for the bridge over Hickory creek. Stack added that the existing plans and permits from 2019 have not expired, and MDOT approval should be simple.

Lakeshore Trail: Gallagher mentioned that there was a cost increase for the proejct, with statewide TAP funidjng increasing proportionally, to remain at 80% of the total.

12. Amendment Approvals

Motion for the Technical Advisory Committee to recommend that the Policy Committee approve the amendments to the TwiNCATS 2023-2026 transportaiton Improvement Program as contained in the meeting packet. Made by Kevin Stack and seconded by Tim Drews. **Motion approved.**

Motion for the Polciy Committee to approve the recommendation from the Technical Advisory committee. Made by Jim Sturdevant and secondedby Denise Cook. **Motion approved.**

13. Privilege of the Floor or Public Comment

Stack mentioned that he had gave a tour of Red Arrow Highway to MDOT TAP staff. The Road Department will be applying for TAP funding for the next phase of the Red Arrow Path, and will work with Bridgman and Stevensville. Getting a concetion through the City of St. Joseph will be the next hurdle.

14. Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at 10:20 AM. The next TwinCATS meeting is scheduled for Monday, August 19, 2024, at 9:30 AM.
